

Highlights of 1993

The 1993 Annual Meeting was held on Friday, February 19, at the Cleveland Metroparks Zoo and featured a tour of The Rain Forest plus an illustrated explanation of its creation by the Curator of Education, Robert R Mindick.

On March 17 at the Sagamore Hills Safety Center several Transportation Enhancement Projects being proposed in the Cuyahoga Valley under provisions of the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991 (ISTEA) were reviewed.

On April 21 at the Peninsula Library & Historical Society the proposed Transportation Enhancement Projects reviewed at the March meeting were supported and amendments were made to the Council's Code of Regulations.

On May 19 at the Brecksville Public Library CVNRA Superintendentl John P. Debo, Jr., presented his annual State of the Park report.

On September 15 at the Richfield Township Fellowship Hall a resolution was adopted to create a Deer Management Task Force to address the problems of deer/people conflict and make recommendations.

On November 17 at the Walton Hills Village Hall the document "Road to Prosperity", a feasibility study by the National Park Service for designation of the Ohio & Erie Canal Corridor as a National Heritage Corridor, was reviewed and a resolution was adopted to support such designation by the Congress as presented in this report.
