

## **Highlights of 1992**

### **ANNUAL MEETING**

The 1992 Annual Meeting was held on Friday, February 14, in the Clubhouse at the Sleepy Hollow Golf Course in Brecksville. Following dinner, Frances Buchholzer, Director of the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, described the department's program to the assembled members and guests.

### **REGULAR MEETINGS**

On **March 18** at the Boston Township Hall in Peninsula Village the findings of the Boston-Peninsula Fiscal Study which was undertaken under the auspices of the Council were presented.

On **April 22** at the Barlow Community Center in Hudson the plan for the North Cuyahoga Valley Corridor which had recently been completed by the Cuyahoga County Planning Commission was presented.

On **May 20** at the Brushwood Lake Shelter of Metro Parks, Serving Summit County, in Richfield the Council supported the goals and concepts of the North Cuyahoga Valley Corridor plan which had been presented at the previous meeting, and reviewed the National Heritage Corridor concept; also, the Council heard a presentation of the 5-County Comprehensive Development. On **September 16** in the Visitors' Center at the Seiberling Naturealm in Akron representatives of three Council communities reviewed the implications of a proposed new interchange at Seasons Road with State Route 8.

On **November 18** at the Canal Visitor Center in Valley View the Council heard a report of the National Heritage Corridor Feasibility Study being completed for the North Cuyahoga Valley Corridor.
